### Club Information

We are pleased to be able to offer this wide variety of extra curricular activities during the spring term.

#### **CLUBS FOR WHICH NO PAYMENT IS REQUIRED**

**Running:** Children from Years 4, 5 & 6 who enjoy running and would like to work on their fitness can come with Mr Corke and Mrs Munro. The group will go to Heathfield Recreation Ground and return to school in time for lunch. Children should bring their school P.E. kit and a lightweight waterproof jacket to wear in case of rain. If the weather is bad the club will not take place.

**Art:** Mrs Harrison would like all budding artists from Years 1 & 2 to join her for an afternoon of creative art.

**Knitting:** Mrs Keightley and Mrs Moulden teach the basic skills of knitting to the children from Years 3 – 6. Children will be asked to provide their own knitting needles and wool, details of what they need will be sent home at the start of the term.

**Chess:** Mr Corke and Mr Loizos are starting up lunchtime chess clubs for the children from years 2 – 6. No experience is needed; those attending will be placed in groups of children of a similar ability.

**Beginner Recorders:** Children from Years 3 & 4 are welcome to join Mrs Finnemore and learn how to play the recorder, they will need to bring a recorder and the music book (see last week's newsletter)

**Advanced Recorders:** Mrs Finnemore is continuing with the lunch time recorder group for children from years 4 - 6 who attended the club during the autumn term. Those attending will need to have first sitting lunch.

**Film Club:** Mrs Hendry is continuing to run this very popular club for the spring term. Children will be watching a selection of films over the weeks (Parents are advised that some have a "PG" rating and in signing their children up for this club are giving their consent for them to watch these films) and then discussing and writing reviews on them.

**Netball:** The girls and boys from Years 5 & 6 play in the borough mixed netball league during the spring term. For those who are interested in improving their skills and trying out for the teams come along and join the very popular netball club.

**Advanced knitting:** Those children who have mastered the basics and are able to start following a pattern are invited to join Mrs Keightley to develop their skills.

#### **CLUBS RUN BY OUTSIDE AGENCIES (PAYMENT REQUIRED)**

**French:** There are a few spaces remaining and new pupils are welcomed. Small classes give your child the opportunity to excel. **Gymnastics:** Annika Reeder, the ex Great Britain international gymnast has run these very popular and oversubscribed sessions at school for the past few years. The clubs are both full for this term with a waiting list for the Friday group.

**Football:** Paul White has been running sports clubs at school for the last two years. This term he and his coaches will be taking a football club for **boys and girls** from Years 3 & 4.

**Drama:** We are delighted to offer children from Years 5 & 6 the chance to join Upstage Academy, an energetic and unique Drama Company where the emphasis is on developing the children's confidence, working together and having lots of fun. This company is run by two professionally trained actors who use group games and mini performances during the lessons to channel the children's energy into being creative.

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### FREE PLACES FOR FEE PAYING CLUBS

We are able to offer some free places for the fee paying clubs to those children who are eligible for free school meals. If your child is interested in joining one of the above clubs and is either entitled to or having free school meals please complete the slip below and return it along with the slip for the relevant club. All requests will be considered and offers will be made to ensure as many eligible children as possible have the opportunity to participate in a club of their choice during the school year. Requests will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.

### JOINING A CLUB

Please discuss with your child the clubs that are available and make sure they want to take part in the ones that they request a place for. Clubs should not be used as a form of childcare. We expect children to attend their clubs every week; if more than 2 sessions are missed without a valid reason being given then their place will be taken by a child on the waiting list.

If your child would like to attend any of the non paying clubs taking place in the autumn term, please complete and return the reply slip giving your permission. **If your child would like to attend more than one club, please grade them in order of preference.**

For fee paying clubs please fill in the relevant slip/s and send in the **exact payment** either in cash or by cheque **made out to the payee on the slip.** If the club is oversubscribed fees will be returned with children who have not been allocated a place this term.

Places for all clubs will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis, we are aiming to ensure as many children as possible are able to join at least one club. Forms may be returned from **Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> December**, all club lists will close on **Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> December 2009.**

Lists for the clubs will be on display on the front notice board from the afternoon of **Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> January 2010** and clubs will start during the week of **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January.** (Except for advanced gymnastics which will start the following week)

**Bad behaviour will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Children will be asked to leave a club if their behaviour is unacceptable.**
